Selected stories include Tarashankar Banerjee's 'NA', Manik Banerjee's 'HARANER NAATJAMAI' etc.</li> <li>Students will understand BankimchandraChattopadhyay's 'KAPALKUNDALA' as a significant example of romance in Bengali literature, a milestone in the genre of Katha literature.</li> <li>Saratchandra's 'PALLI-SAMAJ' (Village Society) is one of the most well-known social novels in Bengali literature. In this novel, the author has brought out a detailed description of the social strata with great awareness, which will be considered a document of contemporary literature for the students.</li> </ul>
